CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS John D. Findlay (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 5) through well, pump, and pipeline for National Fish Hatchery purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 14, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 14, bears S. 8° 44' E., a distance of 5,314 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 2,228 cfs not to exceed 1,612.570 ac-ft annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 22, 1965

Description of works of diversion, manner, and place of use: Water is produced by means of a drilled well and pumped to the Lahontan National Fish Hatchery where it is used for maintenance and operation of said hatchery, which is within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
