CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Carmen Bajoneta has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through developed spring, pipeline, reservoir for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 18, T. 31 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 18 bears N. 16° 12' 38" W., a distance of 1,259.69 feet.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NEVADA STATUTES has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 14, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use.
Water is developed at the spring thence conveyed to a 8,000 gallon reservoir thence conveyed via 719 feet of 1 3/4 inch pipeline to the place of use located within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 13, T. 31 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M. and used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
