CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Jack Meder has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, motor & pressure system for quasi-municipal & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 3, Section 34, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 34, bears S. 15° 51' 30" E., a distance of 1,713.9 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.067/cfs but not to exceed 1.825 m.g. per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 8, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is developed in the well thence pumped to a 500 gallon pressure tank thence conveyed via a distribution system to ten residential units located within block 6 Lot 3, Section 34, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 1.825 m.g. per annum from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
