CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Fred Fulstone, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from West Walker River through Saroni Canal & Ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 15, T. 10 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 15 bears N. 75° 31' W., a distance of 350.0 feet. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

*This certificate changes the place of use of water heretofore appropriated under Docket in Equity C-125, Walker River Decree hence the priority of appropriation and duty of water is as decreed, and is subject to modification of the decree by the Federal District Court on March 9, 1967.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
