CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Eugene B. Longfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, and distribution system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 14, T. 10 N., R. 21 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 14 bears S. 82° 36' 54" E., a distance of 962.18 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator American Telephone and Telegraph Co., or its Agent Bell Telephone Company of Nevada

Post-office address Reno, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.07798 cfs but not to exceed 1440 gallons per day

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 15, 1966

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use water is produced from a drilled well, thence pumped into a 500-gallon storage tank thence by pipeline into kitchen and bathroom facilities in a micro-wave station located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
