CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Paul Diggle has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Lake Tahoe

through intake in Lake, pump, pipelines, and pressure tanks for Quasi-Municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 3 (extended) section 34, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the Nt corner of said Section 34 bears N. 21° 07' E., a distance of 3,665.4 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Paul W. Diggle

Post-office address Zephyr Cove, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.067 cfs but not to exceed 1.095 mg per annum

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 19, 1955

Description of works of diversion manner and place of use: suction line installed in the lakes, pump 400' X 1 1/2" thence to a 500-gallon pressure tank & 1 1/2" distribution lines serving six homes in Lot 3, Section 34, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
