CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ross P. Eardley (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from South Fork of the Humboldt River through pump, ditches, and irrigation system for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 5, T. 31. N., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 5 bears S. 32° 31' E., a distance of 5823.34 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows: Name of appropriator of Humboldt Stake of the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints, a corporation sole. Post-office address Elko, Nevada. Amount of appropriation 0.069 cfs but not to exceed 16.89 ac-ft. per season. Period of use, from as decreed to of each year. Date of priority of appropriation as stated in the terms of the permit.

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 4.13 acres in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 5, T. 31 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M., 1.50 " " " NW 1/4 NW 1/4 " " " " " 5.63

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the priority of water to the land as stated.

This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of waters heretofore appropriated under Proof 00374 of the Edwards Decree, Humboldt River Adjudication Case 2804.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
