CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Frank L. Doyon (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring in Kyle Canyon through Catch Basin, Pump & Distribution system for Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 36, T. 19 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 36 bears N. 10° 57' 42" E., a distance of 279.87 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.00223 cfs but not to exceed 525600 gallons per annum.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 15, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner & place of use:
water is developed at the spring & conveyed into a 30" diameter x 12' vertical catch basin thence pumped to the place of use via 500 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe into a 220 gallon storage tank located within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 36, T. 19 S., R. 56 E., and used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
