CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Mitchell Bidart, Jr. Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump & irrigation system for irrigation & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 11, T. 41 N., R. 28 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 11 bears S. 6° 02' E., a distance of 3091.6 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 3.25 cfs but not to exceed 1154.72 ac. ft. per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation January 19, 1960

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre per annum from all sources.

*This certificate changes the place of use of Permit No. 18530 hence the date of priority is the same as Permit No. 18530.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
