CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John Uhalde has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Toner Spring through tunnel, pipe and troughs for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 27, T. 19 N. R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 27 bears S. 31° 10' W., a distance of 4430 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 140 Statutes of 1913, has determined the date,

source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Alfred and Gracian Uhalde
Post-office address Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0223 cfs or sufficient to water 5,000 sheep.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 22, 1926

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a tunnel and piped through 150' of 2" pipe to 50' of iron troughs within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
