

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard J. Baughman (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well pump & irrigation system for irrigation & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 16, T. 20 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 16 bears N. 48° 07' 58" E., a distance of 149.38 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

33.4 acres in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 16, T. 20 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
