CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ebbie H. Davis has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Eagle Spring through open trench for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 31, T. 25 S. R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Section 31 bears S. 0° 01' W., a distance of 1,329.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Ebbie H. Davis
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.000234 cfs or sufficient to water 15 head of cattle.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 4, 1953

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed at the spring; thence allowed to drain into an open cut 6' X 12' X 6' located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, where cattle are allowed to water.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
