CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Donald T. Hall (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

an underground source (Well #4) through drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal (subdivision) and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 25, T.13N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 25 bears N. 46° 15' 52" W. a distance of 1032.51 feet

situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Kingsbury Water Corp.

Post-office address Stateline, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.5 c.f.s., but not to exceed 58.4 m.g. per annum

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 8, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed at the well, thence conveyed to a 500,000 gallon storage tank, thence through a distribution system to 320 dwellings located within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 25; E 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 24; S 1/4 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23; N 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 26, all in T.13N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M. The water under this certificate is commingled with water under Permits 16833, 16834, 16835, and 18757.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
