CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump & irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 2, T. 32 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 2 bears N. 30° 28' E., a distance of 5,396.39 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lincoln Corporation
Post-office address: Battle Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 6.0 c.f.s., but not to exceed 522.9 acre-feet per annum.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 15, 1961

Table with 7 columns: Description of lands to which water is appurtenant, and 6 columns of acreage data. Includes rows for 5.8 acres, 40.0 acres, 40.0 acres, 31.0 acres, 20.0 acres, 20.0 acres, 17.5 acres, and a total of 174.3 acres.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
