CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Delbert C. Day has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 36, T. 3 S., R. 55 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 36 bears N. 47° 10' E. a distance of 3,748.0 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 3.4 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1000.0 acre-feet annually  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation February 24, 1961

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:  
160 acres in the SW 1/4 Section 36, T. 3 S., R. 55 E., M.D.B. & M.  
40 " " " NW 1/4 SE 1/4 " " " " "  
200 total acres

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre annually from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
