CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settlemeyer, (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 26, T. 33 N., R. 48 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 26 bears S. 37° 21' 46" W., a distance of 5,106.75 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.3342 c.f.s., but not to exceed 241.95 acre-feet annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 18, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped into a 5,000 gallon hydropneumatic tank, from whence it is distributed by a 2 1/2 inch main and a 4 inch main to the places of use located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of said Section 26, where it is used for milling and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
