CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Owen Cox has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, storage tank and trough for stock watering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6, T. 25 S. R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 6 bears N. 25° 45' E., a distance of 1,238.0 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0031 c.f.s. or sufficient water to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 10, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped into a storage tank and conducted thence by pipeline to a watering trough located in the same 40 acre legal subdivision as the point of diversion, where it is used for stock watering and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
