CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Dr. Walter R. Bell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from The Truckee River through diversion works and headgate on Steamboat Canal for irrigation, stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 31, T. 19 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 31 bears S. 62° 04' E., a distance of 3,195.0 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

* This certificate changes the place of use of Claim No. 61, and is supplementary to a portion of Claim No. 70 Truckee River Final Decree, in Equity Docket A-3, in the District Court of the United States of America, in and for the District of Nevada.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
