CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wallace T. Boundy (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 2, T. 16 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 2 bears S. 32° 40' 42" W., a distance of 948.42 feet, situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.038 c.f.s., but not to exceed 8.96 mg annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 9th, 1964

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped into 250 gallon pressurized storage tank from where it is distributed for quasi-municipal purposes by pipe lines to a house, cabins, garden and landscaping with lawn and trees covering approximately 1 acre, all located within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of said Section 2.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
