CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS David E. Bell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring through collection box, pump, tank and distribution system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9, T. 13 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 9 bears N. 88° 15' 20" E., a distance of 887.14 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Genoa, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.1 c.f.s., but not to exceed 525,600 gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 7, 1965

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected in a 500 gallon concrete box and pumped to an 85 gallon metal storage tank from whence it is distributed for domestic and normal landscaping purposes, within portions of the S 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 4, and N 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 9, or Lot 15 of Genoa Estates Subdivision, all T. 13 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
