CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Howard E. Ingersoll has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 16, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said section 16 bears N. 70° 17' E., a distance of 737.0 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Howard E. & Cleo F. Ingersoll, Raymond W. & Elaine L. Chester

Post-office address: Minden, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 1.0 c.f.s., but not to exceed 36.92 acre-feet annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: January 16, 1967

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: 9.23 acres in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 16, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit, and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
