CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS John D. Findlay, Regional Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and pipeline for

Operation of a National Fish Hatchery purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said section 23 bears N. 48° 38' E., a distance of 1,266.0 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife United States of America, Dept. of the Interior.

Post-office address Portland, Oregon

Amount of appropriation 1.147 c.f.s., but not to exceed 828.55 acre-feet per annum

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 22, 1964

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump and motor. The water is conveyed to the Lahontan National Fish Hatchery via a pipe line where it is used for operation and maintenance of a National Fish Hatchery within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M. The water is used non-consumptively at the hatchery and is discharged in the Allerman Canal and/or the East Fork of the Carson River.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
