CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Albert J. Fischer (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for recreational (park water supply) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 3, Sec. 2, T. 15 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW meander corner of said Sec. 2 bears N. 18 7/22' W., a distance of 1,860.38 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: State of Nevada, Dept. of Conservation and Natural Resources, Division of State Parks

Post-office address: Carson City, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.067 c.f.s., but not to exceed 15.8 mg per annum

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: September 25, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed in the well thence pumped to a pressure tank thence conveyed via pipe lines to hydrants throughout the Sand Harbor State Park located within Lots I, II, III, Section 2, T. 15 N., R. 18 E. and used for park water supply.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
