CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and troughs for stockwatering & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 28 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 3, T. 28 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 41° 45' E. a distance of 12,160.0 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chap. 140, Stat. 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joe Echegaray
Post-office address: Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0310 c.f.s. or sufficient water to water 5,000 head of sheep
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 12, 1930

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed in the well thence pumped to a 3800 gallon storage tank thence conveyed via 140' x 2" pipe line to watering troughs of 1400 gallon capacity located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion and used for stock watering.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
