CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wallace T. Boundy, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from a spring (Cuba Lode) through collection box, pipe-line, storage tank & truck haulage for Mining & Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 16 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 31 bears S. 56° 49' 48" E., a distance of 14,236.67 feet, situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Best Chance Mining Company
Post-office address: Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0067 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to: December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 11, 1964

Description of works of diversion, place and manner of use:
Water is collected in a covered steel collection box; thence flows by gravity through about 100 feet of 1" dia. pipe to a 560 gallon storage tank; from whence it is drawn and hauled by truck to the place of use located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, where it is used for mining and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
