CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Caselli, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 29, T. 23 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 32 T. 23 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 26° 59' E., a distance of 6,030.0 feet. Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation... 5.0 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1,280.0 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from... January 1st... to... December 31st... of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation... May 20, 1960

Description of lands to which water is appurtenant:
320 acres in the W 1/2 Section 29, T. 23 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

* This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 18862, hence the date of priority remains the same as Permit 18862.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
