

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry L. Brown has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from \_\_\_\_\_ an underground source \_\_\_\_\_ through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation \_\_\_\_\_ purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 19, T. 16 N., R. 40 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 19 bears N. 32° 44' W. a distance of 3,074.95 feet, situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Amount of appropriation 0.2 c.f.s., but not to exceed 72.8 acre-feet per season  
 Period of use, from April 15th to October 15th of each year  
 Date of priority of appropriation September 13, 1966

Description of lands to which water is appurtenant:  
38 acres in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 19, T. 16 N., R. 40 E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
