CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Boyd N. Rucker has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump & motor & pipeline for stock water & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 26, T.26S., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 26 bears S. 77° 36' 40" W. a distance of 3,015.7 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Boyd N. Rucker
Post-office address: Jean, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.011 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 18, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner & place of use
Water is developed in the well thence to a 1500 gallon storage tank thence conveyed via pipe line to one 300 gallon & one 400 gallon trough located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion and used for stock water and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
