

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank G. Arcularius has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Pine Creek Well) through drilled well, pump & troughs for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 21, T.2N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW corner of T.2N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 28° 43' W., a distance of 23,924.0 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 46, Stat. 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0267 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from November 1st to May 31st of the following year
Date of priority of appropriation January 11, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner & place of use:
Water is developed in the well thence pumped into two tanks of 15,000 & 4,000 gallon capacity storage, thence into watering trough located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion & used for stock watering purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
