

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Theresia Howard has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Red Mountain Creek through diversion dam and ditches for irrigation
