CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard W. Arden - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for industrial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 9 of Sec. 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/2 corner of said Sec. 7 bears S. 8° 43' 28' W., a distance of 1,420.11 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Nevada Aggregates and Asphalt
Post-office address Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 2.46 c.f.s., but not to exceed 61.2 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 7, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from the well to a storage tank, and distributed thence by booster pumps for washing aggregates and then returned to settling ponds, all located within Lots 7, 8, 9, and E 1/2 SW 1/4 of said Section 7, and NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and N 1/2 NE 1/4 of Section 18, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
