CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry C. Conrad (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 9N., R. 65E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 26 bears S. 14° 45' E. a distance of 4,250.0 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 5.4 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1,280.0 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation December 27, 1963

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from all sources. This changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 21714, hence the date of priority remains the same as Permit 21714.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
