CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Walter G. Reid (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and pipelines for manufacturing and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 26, T. 14 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 26, bears N. 7 degrees 07' 48" W., a distance of 2,109.80 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Beatrice Foods Company
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
* Amount of appropriation: 1.0 c.f.s., but not to exceed 180 mg annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to: December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 26, 1969

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from a drilled well to a dairy and 7 homes located within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 26 and the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 14 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., for manufacturing and domestic use.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
