CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Eugene B. Longfield (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 46 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 26 bears N. 89 degrees 40' 10" E. a distance of 1,492.76 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Rio King Land & Investment Co.
Post-office address: San Francisco, California
Amount of appropriation: 2.464 c.f.s., but not to exceed 899.0 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from: May 1st to October 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 5, 1955

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 6 columns: Area (Acres), Section, Township, Range, Meridian, and Total. Rows include 40.4 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 26, T. 46 N., R. 33 E., M.D.M. and a total of 306.5 acres.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
