CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Charles C. Armuth, Jr. (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 16, T.24N., R. 41 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 16 bears N. 84 degrees 16' 50" E., a distance of 2,237.0 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 3.5 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1,144.20 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from March 1st to November 15th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 7, 1959

Description of lands to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 7 columns: Area (Acres), Direction 1, Direction 2, Direction 3, Direction 4, Direction 5, Direction 6. Rows include 37.53 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 9, T. 24 N., R. 41 E., M.D.B.&M., and a total of 286.05 acres.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season from all sources. This Certificate also changes the point of diversion of permit 18202, hence the date of priority remains the same as Permit 18202. The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
