CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Paul Gemmill - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6, T. 1 S., R. 69 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 6 bears S. 1 degree 45' E., a distance of 3,400.3 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Chester H. and Josephine Oxborrow
Post-office address: Caliente, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 2.1 c.f.s., but not to exceed 642.5 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 5, 1962

Table with 7 columns: Description of land to which water is appurtenant, area in acres, and specific land descriptions (e.g., SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 36, T. 1 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B. & M.). Total acres: 128.5.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water for lands irrigated shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
