CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, G. M. Campbell, Chairman of Board has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, tank and pipelines for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 20 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 24 bears N. 48 degrees 55' W., a distance of 460.0 feet, situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.148 c.f.s., but not to exceed 35.0 mg per year
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 12, 1958

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pumped through a pipe line to a 100,000 gallon concrete reservoir located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 20 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M., from which it is distributed to the Town of Fernley, Nevada, for municipal and domestic purposes. The place of use is described as being within the S 1/4 S 1/4 Section 11; SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12; W 1/2 W 1/2 Section 13; N 1/2 N 1/2, SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and E 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 14, T. 20 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
