

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 33, T. 25 N., R. 41 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 33 bears S. 42 degrees 09' W., a distance of 141.0 feet, situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from March 1st to November 15th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 1, 1960

38.8 " " SW 1/4 SE 1/4 " " " "
158.8 total acres

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season from all sources. This certificate also changes the point of diversion of Permit 19084, hence the date of priority remains the same as Permit 19084.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
