CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. E. Sweatt (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 9, T.20N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 9 bears S. 85° 22' 41" E., a distance of 1,220.5 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 0.1172 c.f.s. but not to exceed 23.65 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 15, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well and pumped to a 1900 gallon pressure tank from whence it is delivered through approximately 5600 feet of 3 inch main to 45 individual 3/4 inch connections for property owners serviced by the Eugene Street Water Co., located within the S 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 9, and N 1/2 NW 1/4 Section 16, T.20N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M. Water is commingled with water developed under Permit 21462.

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
