CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Caselli (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from South Aiken Creek through ditches and laterals for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 14N., R. 43E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 3 bears S. 81° 54' W. a distance of 2,740 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Table with 10 columns: Area, and 9 columns for section corners. Row 1: 5.2 acres in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 10, T. 14N., R. 43E., M.D.B.&M. Subsequent rows list specific corner areas: 33.4, 18.2, 33.6, 40.0, 2.0, 26.9, 7.2, 38.6, 11.5, 33.3, 14.1. Total Acres: 264.0

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from all sources

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
