CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry C. Conrad (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 30, T.18N., R.42E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 30 bears N. 41° 06' W. a distance of 246 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

*Amount of appropriation 1.7 c.f.s., but not to exceed 547.57 acre feet annually

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

**Date of priority of appropriation September 17, 1962

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from any and/or all sources.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit No. 20713 hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as permit No. 20713.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
