CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. Peraldo has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Little Cottonwood Spring through Diversion Box & Pipeline for Irrigation & Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 10 T42N R39E MDB&M or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 10 bears N18° 37' E a Distance of 2777.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.04 cfs but not to exceed .0 acre feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 6, 1915

Description of Works of diversion manner and place of use
water is developed at the spring thence conveyed via pipe and ditch to the place of use located within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 10 T42N R39E MDB&M and used for Domestic and to Irrigate 2.0 acres of garden.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
