Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Chapter 128, Statutes 1931, has determined the date,

Description of Works of Diversion, Manner & Place of Use:

Water is developed at the spring in a 4'x6' collection box thence conveyed via a 4" pipeline to the main Marlette System thence via a Distribution System to the place of use located within sections 16, 17, & 18, T. 15 N., R. 20 E., MDM & used for Domestic purposes in the Capitol Complex.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
