CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Travis S. Roberts (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for fish cultural purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Sec. 23, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 23 bears N 12° 25' E., a distance of 3,692 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: The United States of America Bureau of Sport Fisheries & Wildlife

Post-office address: Portland, Oregon

* Amount of appropriation: 0.05 cfs

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: November 20, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed through 2 and 3 inch pipe to the place of use located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 23, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M. Water is used by four families and the incidental purposes in the operation and maintenance of the Lahontan National Fish Hatchery.

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
