CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Henry C. Conrad (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Swain Spring No. 1 through pipe and water tank for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 16 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 10 bears S 57° 55' E a distance of 2450 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

*Amount of appropriation 0.00031 cfs or sufficient to water 10 head of horses.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 29, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a spring and conveyed through 1 1/2 inch pipe to a 5 foot diameter water tank where it is used to water 10 horses within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 10, T. 16 N., R. 63 E., MDB&M.

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
