CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS John W. Griswold (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (White Rock Well) through drilled well pump and trough for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 44 N., R. 38 E., M. D. B. & M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 18 bears N 48° 44' W a distance of 2857 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: United States Dept. of Interior Bureau of Land Management
Post-office address: Winnemucca, Nevada
*Amount of appropriation: 0.0062 cfs or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use, from: May 1 to July 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 1, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and pump and conveyed to a watering trough where it is used to water approximately 200 head of cattle within Section 18, T. 44 N., R. 38 E.

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
