CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles A. Nelson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Paradise Canyon Creek through diversion, dam and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 39N., R. 38E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 28 bears N. 82° 03' W. a distance of 707 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

*Amount of appropriation 1.05 c.f.s. but not to exceed 101.8 acre feet per season

Period of use, from March 1 to November 1 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 30, 1969

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 25.45 acres in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 34, T. 39N., R. 38E., M.D.B. & M.

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season from all sources

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
