CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Charles C. Armuth, Jr. (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 13, T.45N., R.33E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 13 bears N. 1° 19' W., a distance of 1,362.1 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 3.515 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.395.6 acre feet per season
Period of use, from March 1 to November 30 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 31, 1961

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 10 columns: Acres, Section, Township, Range, Meridian, and Quarter. Rows list land parcels such as 39.7 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 13, T.45N., R.33E., M.D.B.&M., and 348.9 Total Acres.

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*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
