CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Bertrand Paris, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and storage tank for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 2 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner Sec. 17, T. 3 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 7 degrees 45'36" E., a distance of 46,333.65 feet, situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 0.0155 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 2,500 head of sheep
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 22, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed through 4-inch pipe to a 20,000 gallon storage tank and 150 feet of watering troughs where it is used to water approximately 2,500 head of sheep within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6, T. 2 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
