

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Mark Chilton (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 2) through drilled well, pump and tank for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 21 N., R. 46 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 9 bears S. 22 degrees 35' E., a distance of 2,144 feet, situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.03125 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 20, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and conveyed to a 500 gallon stock tank where it is used to water approximately 1,000 head of cattle within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 21 N., R. 46 E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit
** This certificate changes the manner of use of Permit 23414, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Permit 23414.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
